Worship Life

1. Develop and lead Children's Worship once or twice a month.
2. Lead or assist in the selection of material for Story for all ages two or three times a month.
3. Lead and expand opportunities for multi age worship.
4. Articulate the life passages of children and youth through conversation and ritual.
5. With the senior minister, create and lead multi generational services and celebrations.

Leadership Development

1. Provide leadership in the selection and development of program materials for lifespan religious education.
2. Develop leadership through training and locating training resources for classroom leaders, youth leaders and RE committee members.
3. Presence and voice in the local community for UU family values.

Religious Growth and Learning

1. Work with the Religious Education committee to develop a whole vision of the Life Span RE Program and all its ministries, worship, teaching and learning, fellowship and community building and social action.
2. Provide leadership in the areas of learning theory and spiritual development.
3. Provide leadership in helping UUC assess and redesign its ministry.

Parish

1. Preaching – 7 or 8 times during the year including Christmas Eve
2. Counseling/pastoral care in collaboration with the senior minister
3. Teaching one or two adult education classes including 'Pathways to Membership'
4. Coordinating Covenant Groups, UUC's small group ministry program
5. Working with staff and supervise RE staff
6. Board and Committee Participation
7. Weddings, Memorial Services, Child Dedications
