

Hospitality Report

Hospitality currently consists of a single chairperson - Cindi Nohe - and the wonderful volunteers who step up to help every single Sunday.

The role of the hospitality chair is to secure volunteers to help with the Social Hour each Sunday after services. Currently, if no volunteers are available, the chairperson serves in this capacity. The optimal number of volunteers is two, but the job can be done effectively by a single person when necessary.

The volunteers arrive in the Social Hall before services, usually about 9:45 and start preparations. Tablecloths need to cover the serving tables, paper products are arranged, and food trays can be prepared and covered. The volunteers then attend the service and return to the Social Hall during the closing music. The punch is made, the food is set out, and other details are handled. During the Coffee Hour, these same volunteers make sure supplies are replenished. As the crowd begins to thin, coffee cups and food trays are washed, surface areas are cleaned, and the kitchen is generally put back in order. It's pretty straightforward and specific directions are posted for the dishwasher. Also, detailed directions are available for those new to this position.

These volunteers work tirelessly all year round and without them, none of us would be enjoying the extraordinary coffee (thank you Jeanine), and snacks while we socialize every Sunday. So thank you to all of the volunteers who have come forward to help.
